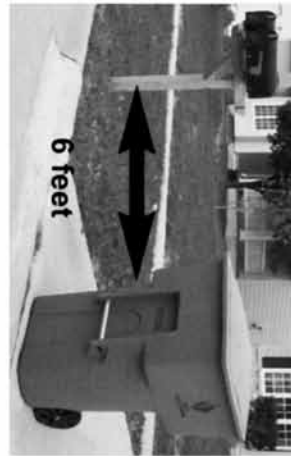
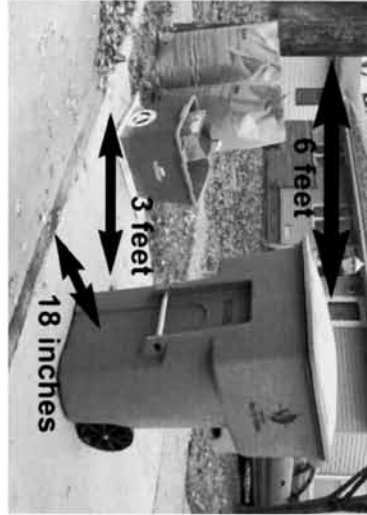

Please note there is a possibility the dates of collection may change due to the volume of debris collected on a particular route. For example, if Monday's route has high volumes to collect, Tuesday's route may be delayed by one day or only part of Tuesday's route will be collected with the remainder being collected on Wednesday.

If you miss this year's annual clean up, remember you can put out large items 52 weeks a year by purchasing large item stickers at your local Hy-Vee or Dahls customer service center or call us at 262-4040.

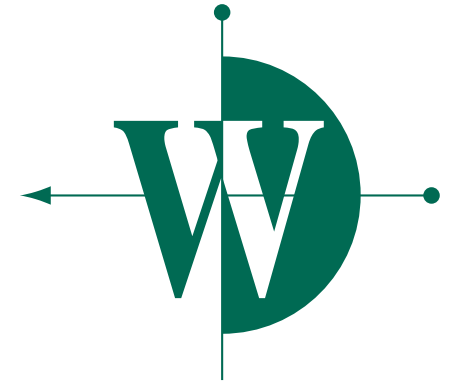


Cart is blocked by vehicle and is too close to Curb (It bin and yard waste bags.

THE WEST DES MOINES ANNUAL CLEANUP DAYS

The City of West Des Moines and Artistic Waste Services Inc. are providing this annual cleanup as part of their service agreement. The cost of this program is covered by your monthly solid waste service charge.

Your cleanup day for West Des Moines Annual Cleanup has changed. Please see the dates on the back page. Please set your items on the curb after 5:00 PM the night before or before 6:00 AM on your collection day. Please do not use your Toter cart. All small material must be bagged, boxed or bundled to be picked up. Loose debris will be rejected.

This will be the only cleanup day for your neighborhood. Residents that miss their collection day will not have Clean up service available the following week. This service is for West Des Moines residents only. Any material that is imported from outside the City will be rejected and hauled away at the owner's expense.

Solid waste will be collected on your regularly scheduled date during cleanup.

EXAMPLES OF ITEMS THAT ARE ACCEPTED IN THE ANNUAL CLEANUP PROGRAM:

- tables and chairs
- couches
- loveseats
- mattresses
- box springs
- carpet rolls (4 feet in length and bundled; less than 45 lbs.)
- lawn furniture
- gas grill (without propane tank)
- hoses

Normal material generated by a residential household is generally accepted.

APPLIANCES/WHITE GOODS WILL NO LONGER BE COLLECTED IN THE ANNUAL CLEANUP!

The items that are considered appliances are: refrigerators, air-conditioners, freezers, stoves, washers, water heaters, de-humidifiers, and dishwashers. These appliances contain refrigerants, PCPs, mercury components, or electrical parts. Appliances/White goods can be collected year round by calling Artistic and arranging for a special pick-up.

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED IN THE ANNUAL CLEANUP PROGRAM:

- appliances / white goods
- buildings, major building parts, building material
- tires
- railroad ties
- normal yard waste that can be disposed of on your regular trash day
- vehicles and/or major auto parts
- concrete chunks (all sizes)
- asphalt shingles over 65 lbs. in total weight
- animal carcasses
- lead / acid / car batteries
- waste oil
- explosive material
- drugs
- poisons
- highly combustible material
- paint
- medical waste
- any other toxic or hazardous substances
