



Important Notice Regarding Snow Emergency Parking Bans



Do you park on West Des Moines city streets?
Be sure to have an alternate PLAN in place for this winter.

Snowplows can't clean the streets if cars are parked on them!

In the event the City receives measurable snowfall and plowing activities are implemented, there may be a PARKING BAN in place. That means NO PARKING on all city streets for the duration of the ban. Vehicles are subject to a \$50 fine or may be towed!

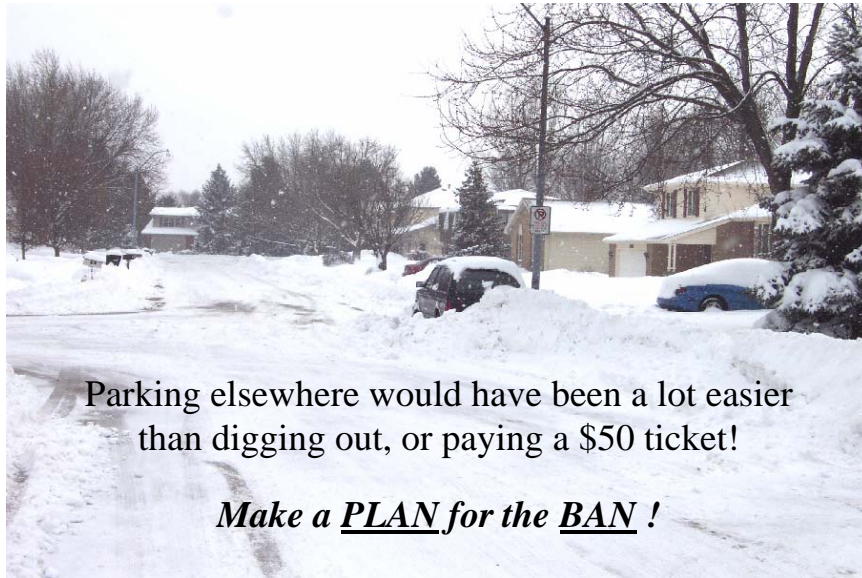
