



Important Notice Regarding Snow Emergency Parking Bans



In the event the City receives measurable snowfall and plowing activities are implemented, there may be a **PARKING BAN** in place. That means **NO PARKING** on all city streets, alleys, and city-owned parking areas for the duration of the ban. Vehicles are subject to a \$50 fine or may be towed!
