 Ratifying Contract Extension with Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities (IAMU) for As-Needed Financial Services

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Hourly rate of \$96.51 for consulting services. Total cost will be based on number of hours required for financial services.

SUMMARY:

Approval of a contract with IAMU will allow part-time, as-needed financial services to assist with critical and time sensitive day to day operations. Paula Meyer, former Finance Manager and Treasurer, would be assigned by IAMU upon request. This service agreement extends the original contract period approved by the Board in January 2018, which was reviewed by Amy Beattie of Brick Gentry.

BACKGROUND:

WDMWW has a finance and accounting department with two full-time employees. In the event of illness or extended vacation of one of the employees it becomes difficult to maintain the necessary day-to-day operations. Due to the nature of the work, cross training of existing employees from other departments or utilizing an untrained temporary employee is not feasible. Extension of the current PULL Agreement with IAMU allows for as-needed, temporary assistance from a trained, experienced source.

SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement between the Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities (IAMU) and West Des Moines Water Works (WDWW) (hereafter Utility) describes services requested by the Utility from IAMU and the terms and conditions of their provision. The Agreement may be amended at any time by the mutual agreement of the Parties.

Section 1. Description of Services to be provided by IAMU		Due to the retirement of the Finance Manager the "Utility" requests that IAMU provide accounting and management support services from July 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019. IAMU will provide qualified personnel from its staff, which includes a pool of retired utility employees (Employee). Duties include directing other Utility employees, administering the Utility Services work plan, budget and audit, and providing advice and timely reports to the Board of Directors on the activities and financial condition of the Utility. The individual(s) assigned to perform the services shall be available as needed during the term of the agreement.
	Section 2. Term	The contract will begin July 1, 2018 and end March 31, 2019.

Section 4. Compensation (check those that apply)		The Utility agrees to reimburse IAMU for performance of this agreement on the following basis: Hourly @ \$96.51 per hr. The hourly rate is based on the assumption that 'AMU is able to assign a qualified person acceptable to the Utility Board of Directors at an hourly rate of \$96.51. The rate includes compensation for vacation and holidays, so there is no paid time off. IAMU will bill the Utility every two weeks on the basis of the employee's actual hours worked during each pay period. Other or alternate compensation (Describe): If the Employee assigned by IAMU to provide services under this agreement is required to be paid an hourly rate other than \$96.51 or if the services requested by the utility are performed by more than one IAMU employee, the terms and conditions for compensation of additional or alternate employees shall be identified in an attached agreement approved by the Parties.
	Travel to and from work	An IAMU employee living within 25 miles of the worksite shall use his/her privately owned vehicle at his/her own expense to commute to and from work. In the event that IAMU assigns a staff person acceptable to the Utility, but living more than 25 miles from the worksite, travel time would be addressed in an addendum or by replacing this contract.
Section 5.	Work-related travel and expenses	Expenses deemed to be reasonable and necessary for performance of the service and purchased at the employee's expense for use by the Utility, at an amount not to exceed \$50.00 for each separate purpose (e.g., supplies, parts & materials) and for which the normal requisition process could not reasonably be used). All other purchases will be made through the utility's normal requisition process.

		Reimbursement for work-related travel expenses of the Employee shall be made directly by the Utility following the Utility's normal practice.

Section 6. Billing & Payments		IAMU will bill the Utility bi-weekly based on the number of hours paid to the employee in each pay period based upon IAMU's pay cycle. All invoices shall be du within 10 days of receipt.

Utility to provide	 Access to Utility staff, records, and facilities necessary to provide services Workspace, access to computer, internet, copy machines, and printers, as needed Other (describe, e.g., vehicle for on-job use, cell phone): A Utility vehicle shall be provided by the Utility for on-the-job use, including travel to and from any meetin normally attended by the Utility manager.

Termination and assignment		The Agreement may be terminated without cause by either party with 40 days writ notice delivered by first class mail, UPS, Fed Ex, by fax to IAMU (515-289-2499) email to tdeioode@iamu.org . Utility shall be obligated to pay all costs incurred up the time of termination, including labor and overheads, administrative and ot expenses provided for herein.
